
Drop in civic protests in 2017

The Civic Protest Barometer tracks <u>civic protests</u> across South Africa, which are a specific form of protest, directed at municipalities. The barometer shows:

- The number of civic protests fell in 2017 (from 170 in 2016 to 123 in 2017), reaching the lowest level in three years.
- · Civic protests declined 40 percent between 2009 and 2017.
- Since 2013 the number of civic protests has fluctuated in the range of 125 and 175. The number of civic protests seem to have stabilised at approximately 150 a year keeping with the trend since 2007.
- The range of fluctuation in civic protests between years has also decreased since 2013.

The 2018 edition of the Civic Protest Barometer (CPB) will be published in February with further detailed analysis of these and other findings.
