Does constitutional status matter?

South Africa, 3 examples

- Stand-alone status for cities
- Protected revenue: electricity
- Protected planning powers





Stand-alone status

- Constitutional recognition of 'stand-alone' status of largest cities
- Eight metros: single political and planning units
- Law defines who qualifies
- Independent Demarcation Board decides





Electricity

Importance:

	Oper. revenue: electricity/total			
Metro's	32.6%			
Other cities	36.9%			
National Treasury 2011				

- Surplus cross-subsidises other services
- Electricity distribution essential for debt collection
- 2000-2010: nat govt. attempts to regionalise
- Cities resist successfully, backed by Constitution





Land use

- Constitution guarantees cities' power to control land use
 - Johannesburg successfully challenged provincial decision making (tribunals)
 - Cape Town successfully challenged national decision making (mining)
- accelerated devolution of planning powers to cities
- Caveat: city may stop undesirable development but still needs other levels of govt to make development happen
